EXCAVATION OF GRAVEL AT WARE PARK FARM

Redlands Ltd. have now re-applied for planning permission to excavate part of the site previously proposed. The new application would still involve the use of the washing plant at Waterford and so all previous objections concerning lorry traffic along Sacombe Road still apply.

The County Council have informed us that as this is a new application letters of objection concerning the previous application may be disregarded. Residents are therefore urged to write <u>new</u> individual letters of objection referring to the September public meeting, to the petition, and to any previous individual letters on this matter. Letters should be addressed to: Mr. G. Steeley, County Planning Officer, Hertfordshire County Council, County Hall, Hertford, and should arrive before the end of January.

From the point of view of Molewood Estate, the most important point to stress is the need to close the Waterford washing plant to reduce rather than increase heavy lorry traffic down Sacombe Road.

REAR ACCESS ROADS AND FOOTPATHS

A number of complaints have been received by committee members concerning the illegal use of rear access roads and footpaths (e.g. the alley to the rear of Lys Hill Gardens). Residents are reminded that such pathways are the private property of the few houses they directly serve and are not general rights of way.

A light aircraft has been reported performing dangerous acrobatics over Molewood Estate. The police were called in on one occasion and the Civil Aviation Authority has been notified.
