

A.G.M.

At the A.G.M. on the 26th May - and many thanks to those who attended, more than ever before we believe - several matters were raised, most not for the first time!

- 1. Children are playing games on the small greens we have round the Estate. Please try to ensure that your children do not play ball games on these small areas, the Adventure Playground is provided for these games. Please also try to ensure that children do not disturb other residents with their loud noise. Difficult we know, children will be children (especially boys)!
- 2. Yet another mention was made of cars parked on roads and verges. Cars parked on the road can turn the bus route into a slalom course. Quite often the bus has to stop and the driver sounds his horn because he cannot get through between cars parked on both sides of the road.

Also it can be very frustrating when you cannot reverse out of your own drive in one smooth movement, because of careless parking. It is only thoughtlessness we know, but rather irritating all the same.

Finally, cars parked on grass verges can damage them, then our - rate-payers money has to be used to repair them again.

Not only good fences, but good parking, make good neighbours!

In an effort to help some people with garages behind their houses and no drives in front for second cars, we are to ask the Council about the possibility of making a lay-by in Woodhall Close. This might help one area at least.

- 3. Molewood Pit is what an American might call 'an on-going situation problem wise'! The nuisance, the noise and the disregard of reasonable requests continue, so do your Committee's efforts on your behalf. Members are constantly observing the activities at the Pit, writing letters to the Council and meeting Councillors personally to complain. So please do not think it has all died down, it has not, and it will not, until we get a satisfactory response, and more than that, some reliable evidence that the owners of the Pit are actually honouring their promises. Now that the Election is over we intend to approach our N.F. as the next step.
 - 4. The possible demolition of Bengeo House and the building of forty houses by Harrin-gay Council have caused some alarm. At present we are watching the situation since no formal proposals have been made as yet. Do let us know your views.
 - 5. Some concern has been expressed about the steady expansion of the food-retailing area at the Bengeo Garden Centre, even before the applications have been granted. We are planning to oppose these applications, as we do not feel them to be in the best interests of our own local shops.
